Example to apply for Thrivent Action Team funds

Project description: Our team will purchase the food and deliver the food items. We will then prepare and serve a full lunch for our local homeless outreach facility, the Longmont OUR Center. We usually serve 150-200 clients on a Sunday afternoon. This is often the only meal of the day for these people. We construct the menu to provide a good balance of protein and carbohydrates. We visit with some of the clients and learn their stories. After serving, we then clean up the kitchen and serving spaces, store any leftovers for use later that week, and make sure all is in order.

Seed money: The \$250 will be applied to purchase the food used for this meal. The total cost of the meal is approximately \$300 so this is a wonderful way to enable our team to provide this service to the needy of our community.
